Although this type of tumor is usually benign, the pathology report showed 10% of it to have cancerous changes, so he will be monitored with regular MRI's. He attends school a couple of hours a day, is still quick and bright, and the only after effect of the whole ordeal is that he tires easily and must restrict his activities. He's reading a mountain of books & doing a lot of his schoolwork at home. We are thankful about the timing, because the school year was almost over when he got sick. Thank you and your group for their prayer (I myself have been hospitalized 3 times since Apr. 1 - one in the E/R and two 5 day stays for matters related to each other, so thanks for any extra prayers (trying to stay healthy until my birthday when my daughter will be visiting from Tulsa & I'll get to see my new grandson for the first time!) Families and victims of D.C. train collision. Among those who lost their lives in the collision and derailment on the Washington metro rail network earlier this week that killed train operator Jeanice McMillan and eight other passengers were a military general (Maj. Gen. David F. Wherley Jr. and his wife Ann), a Bible school teacher, and single moms balancing work and children. Dozens more were injured. Investigators continue to look into the cause of the accident.

U.S.-Arab relations. President Obama will return an ambassador to Syria, filling a post that has been vacant for four years. The move is designed to deepen America's role in the Middle East as the President seeks to promote peace among Israel and its Arab neighbors and improve U.S. relations in the region.

U.S. reaction to events in Iran. President Obama says the United States and the international community have been 'appalled and outraged by the threats, beatings, and imprisonments' of the past week. He added that 'the most important thing for the Iranian government to consider is legitimacy in the eyes of its own people, not in the eyes of the United States,' saying it is ultimately up to the Iranian people to decide their leadership and the structure of their government.

Unemployment in the nation. President Obama says 'it's pretty clear now that unemployment will end up going over 10 percent…because of the fact that even after employers and businesses start investing again and start hiring again, typically it takes a while for that employment number to catch up with economic recovery.' He also said the economy is not yet experiencing 'actual recovery yet.'

The nation's housing crisis. Since President Obama's program to address foreclosures was announced March 4, over 600,000 homes have been foreclosed upon or auctioned, while 190,000 mortgage modifications have occurred. The Center for Responsible Lending reports that 2.4 million more Americans are at risk of foreclosure in 2009, and over eight million could be at risk over the next four years.

Substance abuse among our Troops. According to the U.S. Army, the number of Army soldiers enrolled in alcohol treatment programs has doubled since 2003. The rate is currently 11.4 per every 1, 000 soldiers. Marine Corp statistics show a similar trend, with Marines screening positive for drug or alcohol problems increasing by 12 percent since 2005. Immigration reform efforts. Addressing hundreds from the Latino community during the National Hispanic Prayer Breakfast last Friday, President Obama committed to providing a way for millions of undocumented immigrants to become U.S. citizens while also strengthening border security. 'We are now making our voices heard,' said the Rev. Luis Cortes, Jr. in the Christian Post. Cortes Jr. heads Esperanza, the largest Hispanic evangelical network in the country. 'Now we come and we feel indignant when political leaders don't address us or when they address us and don't understand our position.'
